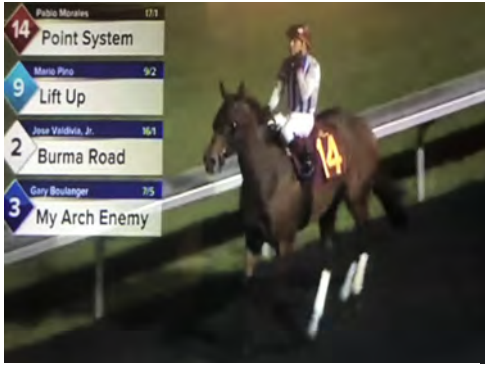

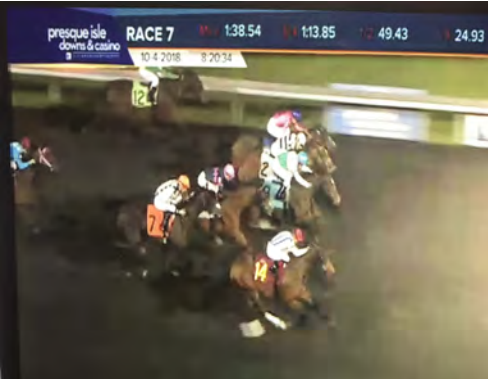

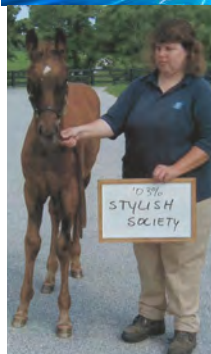
READY TO CONFESS
