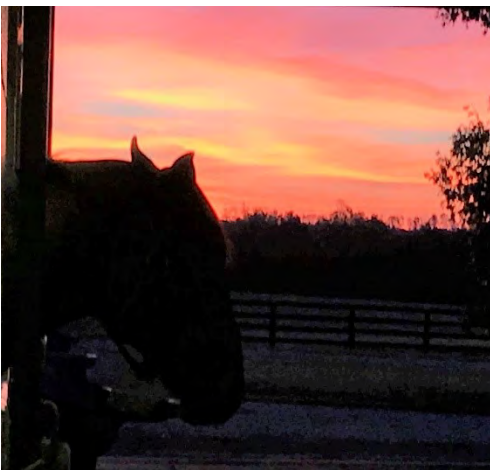
FULL OF ZIP

HIGHER POWER

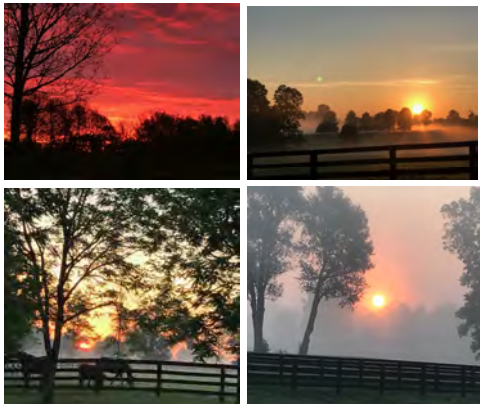
NOV 24 – Coming back from a lay off since spring, he's pointed at an allowance race also at the Fair Grounds for Mike Stidham.

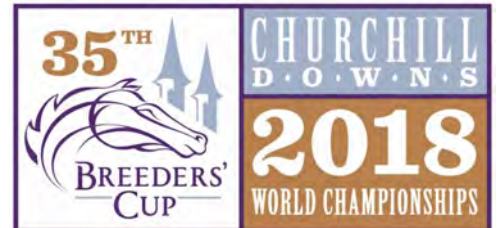
