WE DO NOT USE SHED FORMS. A brief breeding report summary will be given to your mare’s attendant after breeding.

PLEASE BE ON TIME! A veterinarian is in attendance at all breedings and must depart immediately after the last mare is bred.

ALL MARES REQUIRE PROPER I.D. BEFORE COVER, i.e., a halter or neck strap with permanently affixed name plate.

ALL MAIDEN MARES MUST BE JUMPED PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST VISIT. If you have NOT jumped your mare, INFORM THE BOOKING SECRETARY at time of confirmation. This is a serious safety issue for our shed crew, our stallion and your mare.

Please indicate at booking if mare has any characteristics or conditions that our breeding shed needs to be aware of – sight or other physical impairments, difficult to handle or twitch, etc.

“First cover” mares will ALWAYS be given priority over “double” mares.

Pin Oak Stud will make every reasonable attempt to impregnate your mare but reserves the right not to breed the mare at any given session if mare is deemed a danger to the stallion and/or staff.

Please contact us as soon as your mare is presumed in foal !

***** ALL TRIPS TO THE PIN OAK BREEDING SHED WILL REQUIRE A CLEAN UTERINE CULTURE (except doubles) including FIRST-TRIP FOALING MARES. *****

We appreciate your cooperation.

All mares visiting our shed must be vaccinated for equine herpes virus Type I (Rhinomune, Pneumabort-K, etc.) 7 – 90 days before breeding. A statement to this effect should be included on your culture certificate.

Pin Oak Stud will observe all recommended COVID-19 protocols issued by Kentucky’s Office of State Veterinarian.

- All required paperwork (cultures, EHV statements, CEM certificates) shall be submitted electronically to info@pinoakstud.com before cover.
- Outside individuals, including owners, van drivers and attendants, shall not enter the breeding shed or prep area. A separate observation room is available for anyone wanting to witness a covering.
- Mares will be unloaded by van personnel in the parking lot, handed off to a Pin Oak shed crew member who will use a farm shank to handle the mare inside the shed, and then returned to van personnel. Van personnel waiting in the parking area are also requested to observe physical distancing guidelines.
- Pin Oak Stud will continue to observe best biosecurity practices in the breeding shed, including frequent handwashing, physical distancing as possible and cleaning/disinfecting all breeding equipment between and before re-use.

IMPORTED MAIDEN MARES: All fillies of foreign origin require two (2) sets of negative CEM cultures from the clitoral fossa, clitoral sinus(es) and cervix (from cultures collected on days 1, 4 and 7), and one (1) negative CEM culture from the endometrium before being qualified for cover. The endometrial culture may be included with either of the required sets of swabs, or in the case of a pregnant mare, may be collected after foaling. The first three (3) mares bred after the imported filly must be CF tested 15-25 days post-breeding. For those mares bred after an import, proof of CF blood having been drawn will be required for the second visit. Negative results of CF blood are required for the third visit. A negative aerobic uterine culture is required within 30 days prior to the first visit. A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for a third visit and every subsequent visit thereafter (not including doubles). **Maiden mares must be jumped prior to the first visit.**

IMPORTED FOALING & BARREN MARES: Contact the State Veterinarian’s Office in Frankfort, Kentucky regarding testing procedures and acquisition of quarantine releases. A copy of the Quarantine Release must accompany the mare on her first trip to the breeding shed. The first three (3) mares bred after the imported mare will be required to have a CF test drawn 15-25 days post-breeding. Proof of CF blood having been drawn will be required for the second visit. Negative results of CF blood are required for the third visit. A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for barren mares within 30 days of the first visit and again on the third visit and every subsequent visit thereafter (not including doubles). A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for foaling mares on the second visit and every subsequent visit thereafter (not including doubles).
